Rae and Friedenberg are no novices to independent cinema. They have collaborated frequently, dealing with topics as diverse as football, foster care, and Native American poet/activist John Trudell. Rae, a half Cherokee, has been in charge of the Native American Program at Sundance Institute for six years. This year, she won the Institute's prestigious Grand Jury Prize for Best Dramatic Film. Both teach film studies at Boise State University, Idaho.
